or in which I have any interest, in the West half of the Northeast quarter (W¹/2 N¹/2) of Section five (5) Township Fifty-six North of Range Eighty-six West (T56N-R86W) of the Sixth (6th) Principal Meridian, County of Sheridan and State of Wyoming, and upon and along the roads, streets or highways adjoining the said property, with the right to permit the attachment of the wires of any other Company, and the right to trim any trees along said lines so as to keep the wires cleared at least thirty-six inches, to erect and set the necessary guy and brack poles and anchors and to attach thereto the necessary guy wires.
