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Excerpt

32. It was moved by Commissioner Pleak, seconded by Commissioner Guthrie and carried that the following Resolution be adopted:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, certain portions of the previously existing right of way of U.S. Highway 87 and the Decker Secondary Highway in Sheridan County, Wyoming as previously located and traveled, are no longer needed for State highway and public use purposes,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that acting under the provisions of Session Laws of Wyoming, 1959, Chapter 160, Section 1, the following described existing highway right of way be abandoned, to wit:

Decker Road - Project S-265 (2)

"Beginning at a point on the easterly right of way boundary of the presently existing U.S. Highway Number 87 situated in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 22, T. 57 N., R. 34 W. of the 6th P.M., Wyoming, which point of beginning bears N, 54° 28' W. a distance of 450.7 feet from the southeast corner of said Section 22;

thence running in an easterly direction for a distance of approximately 0.585 miles through Sections 22 and 23, said township and range;

To a point of ending on the northwesterly right of way boundary of the presently existing Decker Connection Road, Project No. S-1706, which point of ending being situated in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of said Section 23 and bears N, 56° 40' E. a distance of 33.2 feet, more or less, from a point on the west boundary of said Section 23 from which the west quarter corner thereof bears S 33° 41' E. a distance of 181 feet."

U.S. Highway 87 - Project S-1706

"Beginning at a point on the easterly right of way boundary of the presently existing U.S. Highway No. 27 situated in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 22, T. 57 N., R. 34 W. of

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the 6th P.M., Wyoming, which point of beginning bears S. 70°58' E. a distance of 840.7 feet from a point which bears S. 86°43' E. a distance of 992.5 feet from a point which bears S. 79°54' E. a distance of 158.0 feet from a point on the west boundary of said Section 22 from which the northwest corner thereof bears N. 0°36' E. a distance of 614.0 feet;


thence running in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 0.662 miles through the W 1/2 of said Section 22;

To a point of ending on the northwesterly right of way boundary opposite engineer's approximate station 7 + 14 at the presently existing relocated Decker Connection Road, Project No. S-1706, which point of ending is situated in the SW 1/4 of said Section 22 and bears N. 43°05' E. a distance of 1775 feet, more or less, from the southwest corner of said Section 22."
