VACATION OF PORTION OF PINEDALE AVENUE IN DOWLING SUBDIVISION AT STORY, WYOMING

PINEDALE AVENUE  
VACATION

WHEREAS, a petition and plat were filed with the Board of County Commissioners requesting the vacation of a portion of Pinedale Avenue in the Dowling Subdivision at Story, Wyoming; and

WHEREAS, said proposed vacation was advertised according to law; and

WHEREAS, the only protest received by 12:00 noon on the 15th day of October, 1973, the deadline for filing objections or claims for damages was that of the Montana Dakota Utilities Company;

NOW THEREFORE, a motion was regularly made and carried to vacate that portion of Pinedale Avenue in the Dowling Subdivision at Story, Wyoming more particularly described as Beginning at a point, the same being the Northwest corner of Lot 18 in Block 1 of Dowling Subdivision, Sheridan County, Wyoming; thence Northeasterly on a line perpendicular to the Southerly line of said Pinedale Avenue to the Southerly line of Lot 16, Block 2 of said Dowling Subdivision; thence Southeasterly along the Southerly line of said Lot 16 to the Southeast corner of said Lot; thence Southwesterly across said Pinedale Avenue to the Northeast corner of said Lot 18, Block 1 of Dowling Subdivision; thence Northwest-erly along the Northerly line of said Lot 18 to the point of beginning; said vacation, however, being declared subject to the right of ingress and egress by the Montana Dakota Utilities Company.

NOTICE OF ALTERATION OF ROAD IN FIRST ADDITION TO KILBOURNE PARK, STORY, WYOMING

NOTICE OF ALTERATION

WHEREAS, A petition and plat were filed with the Board of County Commissioners by the property owners using the Existing Access Road in the First Addition to Kilbourne Park Addition, Sheridan County, Wyoming, requesting that the Commissioners vacate that 30 foot reserve for street purposes as shown on the Plat of the First Addition to Kilbourne Park, Story, Wyoming, and in its place to establish another 30 foot access road, said access road to be parallel to the north line of said First Addition and forty-five (45) south of the north line and over lands belonging to John J. Balkenbush; in that the existing access road is not and has never been within the 30 foot reserve as set out on the Plat of the First Addition to Kilbourne Park; and

WHEREAS, said proposed alteration was advertised according to law; and
