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## TEMPORARY ACCESS AND CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT

ELWIN WEBB PHILLIPS and JAMES REED PHILLIPS, both of Sheridan County, Wyoming, hereinafter GRANTORS, for and in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, do grant and convey to the MEAD CREEK DITCH COMPANY IRRIGATION DISTRICT, hereinafter GRANTEE, its employees, agents and contractors, a temporary access easement and construction easement across the following lands, all within Sheridan County, Wyoming, to wit:

SW¼, Section 4, T53N, R83W SE ¼, Section 5, T53N, R83W NE¼, NW¼, SW¼, T53N, R83W.

This temporary easement shall be for those lands shown generally on the attached **Exhibit A**, and shall include the following:

- Strips of land 25 feet in width along the routes shown generally in Exhibit A to allow temporary access for the following activities:
  - construction of a pipeline and ancillary facilities to be owned by GRANTEE, and
  - filling and regrading of an existing channel on GRANTORS' property that has been eroded due to GRANTEE's conveyance of irrigation water through this channel.
- 2. An area of land approximately 1000 feet long by 550 feet wide beneath and upon which GRANTEE proposes to construct a pipeline and ancillary facilities as discussed in Item 1, and to fill and regrade the existing channel as discussed in Item 1.

This temporary easement is granted under the following conditions.

- 1. GRANTORS shall be notified at least 72 hours in advance of GRANTEE's initial access upon the property, and as necessary thereafter.
- 2. Temporary access is permitted only for the purposes allowed by this easement.
- 3. GRANTEE is responsible for locating all underground utilities and irrigation lines prior to any construction.
- 4. GRANTEE shall utilize existing roads or trails for access wherever possible. GRANTEE may construct additional roads along the access strips of land shown generally in Exhibit A, but shall minimize disturbance to trees and other vegetation in areas in which new roads must be constructed. Upon completion of construction of the pipeline and ancillary facilities, and filling and regrading of the existing channel, GRANTEE shall restore all disturbed lands as nearly as possible to their pre-existing condition, including:
  - reshaping, reseeding, fertilizing and mulching those lands upon which GRANTEE constructs roads that as of the date of this easement are grassed lands, and
  - reshaping and regrading existing roads or trails that GRANTEE uses for this temporary access.
- GRANTEE shall take care to protect and/or do no damage to any existing bridges, culverts, cattleguards, or fences located on GRANTORS' property. In the event that such facilities are damaged, GRANTEE shall be responsible for any repairs or replacement.
- 6. GRANTORS acknowledge that reclamation of the existing channel will necessitate removal of trees and other vegetation in order to fill and regrade the channel. GRANTEE shall stockpile and reuse existing topsoil during the fill and regrading operations, and shall reseed, fertilize and mulch the disturbed areas. GRANTORS further acknowledge that they shall receive no compensation for any trees that were disturbed or lost as a result of the construction and reclamation.

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This temporary easement shall become null and void upon expiration of the warranty period provided by the contractor performing the improvements listed above for GRANTEE.	`
