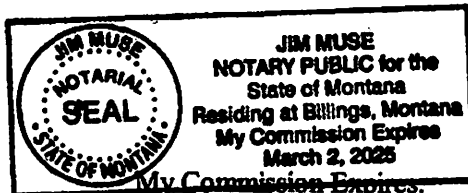

DECREE OF DIVORCE

THIS CAUSE came on regularly for trial this 22nd day of March, 1989, before the Court, sitting without a jury, upon the pleadings on file herein; and the Plaintiff appeared in person and through her attorney, Richard Mathey. Defendant failed to appear either personally or through counsel. The Court, having examined the pleadings on file herein and the records of this case and having heard all of the evidence adduced and the proofs offered and now being well and sufficiently advised in the premises, finds as follows:

1. The Defendant has been duly served with Summons as provided by law in this matter, as shown by the records of this Court; the Defendant has not answered or otherwise pleaded to the Complaint filed against him herein; the time within which the Defendant may answer or otherwise plead has not been extended; the Defendant is not actively serving with the military service of the United States nor with any nation with which the United States is allied; the Defendant is not an infant or incompetent and has not been legally excused from answering or otherwise pleading to the Complaint filed against him herein; and default has been duly entered herein by the Sweetwater County Clerk of District Court as shown by the Certificate of Default on file with said Clerk.

2. Plaintiff has resided in the State of Wyoming for more than sixty (60) days immediately preceding the time of filing of this action, was a resident of Sweetwater County at the time of such filing and now resides in Green River, Sweetwater County, Wyoming.

3. The Court has jurisdiction over the parties hereto, their marriage, their child and their property.

4. The Plaintiff and Defendant were married to one another on May 27, 1978, at Lewistown, Fergus County, Montana, and ever since that time have been, and now are, husband and wife.

5. Plaintiff and Defendant have one (1) child born as issue of this marriage, Randy Richard Shepard, born October 9, 1983. Said child is in the custody of Plaintiff.

6. Child custody, support, visitation and a property division have not been agreed upon by the parties, and therefore must be made by the Court taking into consideration the child's best interests and the various property of the parties and indebtedness of the parties as described by Plaintiff. Regarding child custody, support, visitation and specific property and indebtedness the Court finds:

a. Plaintiff and Defendant are fit and proper persons to have the joint custody, care and control of the parties' minor child, Randy Richard Shepard. Plaintiff requests that she have primary physical custody and that Defendant have normal and reasonable visitation rights with said child, taking into consideration Defendant's employment circumstances, Defendant's ability to properly care for the child, and the child's age. Plaintiff further requests that reasonable notice be required prior to exercising visitation, and that Defendant be required to provide and pay all costs of round-trip transportation for said child when exercising visitation.

b. Defendant is an able-bodied man, currently employed, and is capable of paying to Plaintiff the reasonable sum of Three Hundred Forty Dollars (\$340.00) per month for the support and maintenance of said minor child, and Plaintiff requests that Defendant be ordered to pay said amount to Plaintiff until Randy Richard Shepard attains the age of majority, dies, marries or becomes self-supporting, whichever shall first occur.

c. Plaintiff requests that Defendant be required to maintain health, accident and dental insurance for the benefit of the parties' minor child, and that Defendant be required to pay all medical, hospital, dental, drug, optical, orthodontia or counseling expenses incurred on account of said child which are not covered by insurance.

d. The parties own a townhouse located at 1009 Marion Place, Sheridan, Wyoming, and Defendant is currently making the monthly mortgage payments on said property. Plaintiff requests that Defendant be awarded said property with the provision that if said property is sold, Plaintiff and Defendant will share equally any net equity realized from such sale. Defendant should be entitled to collect any monies realized from the rental of said property.

e. Plaintiff is currently in possession of a 1986 Buick Century automobile, V.I.N. 1G4AH19R0GT429325, registered and titled in the names of Plaintiff and Defendant. Plaintiff requests that she be awarded said vehicle, subject to all liens and encumbrances thereon, all of which Plaintiff assumes and agrees to pay.

f. Defendant is currently in possession of a 1979 Ford one-half ton pickup truck, V.I.N. F14SRFA-2620, registered and titled in the names of Plaintiff and Defendant. Plaintiff requests that Defendant be awarded said vehicle.

g. Plaintiff is currently in possession of a 1978 Honda Express motorcycle, Serial Number NC502018326, registered and titled in Plaintiff's name. Plaintiff requests that she be awarded said vehicle.

h. Plaintiff requests that Defendant be awarded the following personal property of the parties currently in Plaintiff's possession:

i. Artwork consisting of "Antelope Ridge", #338, by Morten Solberg and "Black Magic at Little Lake" by Ralph McDonald.

ii. Firearms consisting of one Oliver F. Winchester 94 Serial Number OFW18475; one Winchester Model 9422 XTR22 Caliber Rifle; one Marlin Model 1894 44 Caliber Remington Magnum; one Winchester Model 9422M XTR22 Magnum and one Winchester Model 9432 Special.

iii. Furniture and appliances consisting of a five piece Rachlin dining room set, one Whirlpool freezer and one double bed with frame.

iv. One Norman Rockwell plate, "Dreaming in the Attic."

v. All camping equipment.

i. Plaintiff requests that Defendant be awarded the personal property of the parties currently in his possession, subject to the provisions of Paragraph 6(s); all his personal belongings and effects; and all checking, savings, investment and retirement accounts held in his name, subject to the provisions of Paragraph 6(q).

j. Plaintiff requests that Defendant be awarded one bronze cast, "Bear and Cub", #28, by Harry L. Rattey, currently in Defendant's possession.

k. Plaintiff requests that she be awarded all personal property of the parties currently in her possession, subject to the provisions of Paragraph 6(h).

l. Plaintiff requests that she be awarded all her personal belongings and effects and those of the parties' minor child; and all checking, savings, investment and retirement accounts held in her name, subject to the provisions of Paragraph 6(q).

m. Plaintiff is currently indebted to Visa and agrees to pay said debt.

n. Defendant is currently indebted to Mastercard and Plaintiff requests that Defendant be required to pay said debt.

o. Plaintiff and Defendant are currently indebted to Discover and Plaintiff requests that Defendant be required to pay said debt.

p. Plaintiff requests that the parties be required to file a joint Federal income tax return for 1988 and to equally share any refund due them. Plaintiff further requests that if additional taxes are owed to the Internal Revenue Service Defendant be required to pay said taxes.

q. Plaintiff and Defendant possess a savings account at Stauffer Big Island Federal Credit Union in the names of both parties. Plaintiff requests that Plaintiff and Defendant be required to share equally the funds in said account.

r. Defendant possesses an insurance policy with Universal Life Insurance through State Farm Insurance. Plaintiff requests that Defendant be required to maintain said policy and name Randy Richard Shepard as the beneficiary of said policy for so long as Defendant is obligated to make child support payments to Plaintiff on account of said child.

s. The parties own a Zenith camcorder which Plaintiff requests be awarded to her and which she agrees to allow Defendant to use during periods of visitation with the parties'

minor child providing said camcorder is returned at the end of such visitation in good working order. Said camcorder is currently in Defendant's possession.

6. Plaintiff requests that each of the parties be responsible for his or her own debts incurred subsequent to June 22, 1988, the date of separation.

7. Irreconcilable differences exist in the marital relationship of Plaintiff and Defendant, Plaintiff is the aggrieved party, and Plaintiff should be granted a divorce from the Defendant for such cause.

8. This action is not founded in, nor exhibited by, collusion between the parties, and Plaintiff is not guilty of the same misconduct as is charged against Defendant.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Kristine Diane Shepard, Plaintiff herein, be, and she is hereby, granted, awarded and decreed an absolute divorce from Roy Richard Shepard, Defendant herein, and the bonds of matrimony be, and the same are hereby, cancelled and set aside.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Plaintiff and Defendant be awarded the joint care, custody and control of the parties' minor child, Randy Richard Shepard, with Plaintiff being awarded primary physical custody subject to normal and reasonable visitation rights for Defendant, taking into consideration Defendant's employment circumstances, Defendant's ability to properly care for the child, and the child's age; Defendant shall be and is hereby required to provide reasonable notice prior to exercising visitation and shall provide and pay all costs of round-trip transportation for said child when exercising visitation.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant shall pay to Plaintiff the sum of Three Hundred Forty Dollars (\$340.00) per month for the support and maintenance of said minor child. The first of said payments shall be due on the 1st day of March, 1989, and shall continue with subsequent payments due and payable on the same day of each and every month thereafter until said child attains the age of majority, dies, marries or becomes self-supporting, whichever shall first occur.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that said payments shall be made to the Clerk of District Court, P.O. Box 430, Green River, Wyoming 82935, and each party shall give notice to the Clerk of Court in writing within fifteen (15) days of any change in his or her address or employment. It is hereby ordered that any current or future payor of income shall withhold a portion of the income as provided by W.S. 20-6-201 through 20-6-222 to provide for payment of support directed by this Order. Any such payor shall comply with all notices from the Clerk of District Court served upon such payor and shall remit income withheld to the Clerk as specified in the notice. The withholding of income shall commence either effective upon the filing and service of a voluntary application by the Obligor; or effective upon the filing of a notice of delinquency and subsequent order of this Court, pursuant to the provisions of W.S. 20-6-201 et seq; W.S. 1977, 1986 Cumm. Supp.

separate property, free and clear of any claims or demands of  
Defendant, subject to all liens and encumbrances thereon the  
following:

a. One 1986 Buick Century automobile,  
V.I.N. 1G4AH19R0GT42925, registered and titled  
in the names of Plaintiff and Defendant.

b. One 1978 Honda Express Motorcycle,  
Serial Number NC500018326, registered and titled  
in the name of Plaintiff.

c. All personal property of the parties  
currently in her possession, subject to the  
provisions of Paragraph 6(h) above.

d. One Zenith camcorder, subject to the  
provisions of Paragraph 6(s) above.

e. All checking, savings, investment and  
retirement accounts held in Plaintiff's name,  
subject to the provisions of Paragraph 6(q)  
above.

f. One-half of the funds in the parties' Stauffer Big Island Federal Credit Union account.

g. All Plaintiff's personal belongings and effects and those of the parties' minor child.

a. One 1979 Ford pickup truck, V.I.N. F14SRF1-2620, titled and registered in the names of Plaintiff and Defendant.

b. All personal property of the parties currently in his possession subject to Paragraph 6(s) above; artwork, firearms, furniture, appliances, a Norman Rockwell plate and camping equipment currently in Plaintiff's possession, as more specifically described in Paragraph 6(h) above; and a bronze cast currently in Defendant's possession.

c. All checking, savings, investment and retirement accounts held in Defendant's name, subject to the provisions of Paragraph 6(q) above.

d. One-half of the funds in the parties' Stauffer Big Island Federal Credit Union account.

e. All Defendant's personal belongings and effects.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Plaintiff shall pay the indebtedness owing to Visa, and that Defendant shall pay the indebtedness owing to Mastercard and Discover; that the parties shall file a joint Federal income tax return for 1988 with the parties equally sharing any refund and the Defendant paying any deficiency payable on said tax return; and that each of the parties shall be responsible for his or her own debts incurred subsequent to June 22, 1988.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant shall maintain the insurance policy currently held by him with Universal Life Insurance through State Farm Insurance, and the Defendant shall name Randy Richard Shepard as the beneficiary of said policy for so long as Defendant is obligated to make child support payments to Plaintiff on account of said child.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Plaintiff and Defendant shall indemnify one another from all liability for any part of any indebtedness ordered to be paid by him or her hereunder, and from all actions, proceedings, claims, demands, costs, damages and expenses in respect to said debts or liabilities.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that both parties are hereby given judgment for all rights, benefits and property awarded to them herein, and the right to have execution



issued therefor. Without in any way limiting the generality or effectiveness of the foregoing, each of the parties hereto shall execute all conveyances, assignments and other instruments necessary or desirable to effectuate and carry out the terms of this Decree.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the parties abide by all terms and conditions of this Decree of Divorce.

4. The Decree of Divorce states in the second full paragraph on page 5, the following:



l. Plaintiff requests that she be awarded all her personal belongings and effects and those of the parties' minor child; and all checking, savings, investment and retirement accounts held in her name, subject to the provisions of Paragraph 6(q).

m. Plaintiff is currently indebted to Visa and agrees to pay said debt.

n. Defendant is currently indebted to Mastercard and Plaintiff requests that Defendant be required to pay said debt.

o. Plaintiff and Defendant are currently indebted to Discover and Plaintiff requests that Defendant be required to pay said debt.

p. Plaintiff requests that the parties be required to file a joint Federal income tax return for 1988 and to equally share any refund due them. Plaintiff further requests that if additional taxes are owed to the Internal Revenue Service Defendant be required to pay said taxes.

q. Plaintiff and Defendant possess a savings account at Stauffer Big Island Federal Credit Union in the names of both parties. Plaintiff requests that Plaintiff and Defendant be required to share equally the funds in said account.

r. Defendant possesses an insurance policy with Universal Life Insurance through State Farm Insurance. Plaintiff requests that Defendant be required to maintain said policy and name Randy Richard Shepard as the beneficiary of said policy for so long as Defendant is obligated to make child support payments to Plaintiff on account of said child.

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minor child providing said camcorder is returned at the end of such visitation in good working order. Said camcorder is currently in Defendant's possession.

t. Plaintiff requests that each of the parties be responsible for his or her own debts incurred subsequent to June 22, 1988, their date of separation.

7. Irreconcilable differences exist in the marital relationship of Plaintiff and Defendant, Plaintiff is the aggrieved party, and Plaintiff should be granted a divorce from the Defendant for such cause.

8. This action is not founded in, nor exhibited by, collusion between the parties, and Plaintiff is not guilty of the same misconduct as is charged against Defendant.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Kristine Diane Shepard, Plaintiff herein, be, and she is hereby, granted, awarded and decreed an absolute divorce from Roy Richard Shepard, Defendant herein, and the bonds of matrimony be, and the same are hereby, cancelled and set aside.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Plaintiff and Defendant be awarded the joint care, custody and control of the parties' minor child, Randy Richard Shepard, with Plaintiff being awarded primary physical custody subject to normal and reasonable visitation rights for Defendant, taking into consideration Defendant's employment circumstances, Defendant's ability to properly care for the child, and the child's age; Defendant shall be and is hereby required to provide reasonable notice prior to exercising visitation and shall provide and pay all costs of round-trip transportation for said child when exercising visitation.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant shall pay to Plaintiff the sum of Three Hundred Forty Dollars (\$340.00) per month for the support and maintenance of said minor child. The first of said payments shall be due on the 1st day of March, 1989, and shall continue with subsequent payments due and payable on the same day of each and every month thereafter until said child attains the age of majority, dies, marries or becomes self-supporting, whichever shall first occur.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that said payments shall be made to the Clerk of District Court, P.O. Box 430, Green River, Wyoming 82935, and each party shall give notice to the Clerk of Court in writing within fifteen (15) days of any change in his or her address or employment. It is hereby ordered that any current or future payor of income shall withhold a portion of the income as provided by W.S. 20-6-201 through 20-6-222 to provide for payment of support directed by this Order. Any such payor shall comply with all notices from the Clerk of District Court served upon such payor and shall remit income withheld to the Clerk as specified in the notice. The withholding of income shall commence either effective upon the filing and service of a voluntary application by the Obligor; or effective upon the filing of a notice of delinquency and subsequent order of this Court, pursuant to the provisions of W.S. 20-6-201 et seq; W.S. 1977, 1986 Cumm. Supp.
