R. 54 W. as follows: beginning at the S.W. corner of the said S.W. 1/4 S.E. 1/4. thence running East on Sec. line to the S.E. corner of said S.W. 1/4 S.E. 1/4. thence North along East line of said S.W. 1/4 S.E. 1/4. 1180 feet to the intersection of said East line with South bank of Sheridan Town Ditch. thence South westerly along said South bank as follows: S. 88° 48' W. 100 feet; thence S. 74° 43' W. 220 feet; thence S. 66° 13' W. 130 feet; thence S. 45° 45' W. 200 feet; thence S. 53° 43' W. 110 feet; thence S. 55° 53' W. 240 feet; thence S. 65° 23' W. 269 feet; thence S. 61° 14' W. 51 feet to the West line of said S.W. 1/4 S.E. 1/4; thence South along said West line 345 feet to the place of beginning.
