Right of Way Deed.

Know all men by these presents that I Charles N Diety of the City of Omaha, County of Douglas, State of Nebraska, in consideration of One Dollar to me in hand paid by the United States of America, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the United States of America, the right of way, in perpetuity, in and to a strip of land ten (10) feet in width over and across the land hereinafter described, in conformity with the Engineer's survey and plat now on file in the office of the Town Clerk of the town of Sheridan, Wyoming, together with the perpetual right to lay down, construct and maintain under said right of way a pipeline for the purpose of conveying sewage from Fort Mackenzie, Wyoming, said pipe to be covered to a depth of five (5) feet together with the further rights so long as said pipe line shall be maintained, to go upon said right of way for all purposes connected therewith; said right of way being described as follows: A strip of Land ten (10) feet in width and Twenty five hundred (2500) feet in length, more or less, beginning at the east line of section sixteen (16) Town fifty six (56) North, Range eighty four (84) west, extending in an easterly direction to Big Horse Creek, through the north half (N¹/₂) of the Northwest quarter (NW¹/₄) of section fifteen (15) Town fifty six (56) north, range eighty four (84) west provided, however, that said right of way shall be so used and maintained as to cause the least interference to the use of the surface thereof for agricultural purposes by the grantor or his assigns.
