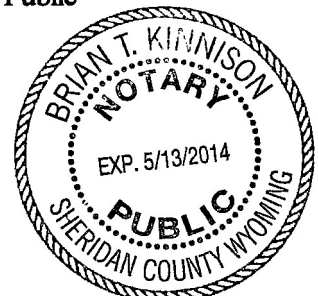

A 25 foot wide Drainage Easement located in the Southeast 1/4 of Section 2, T55N, R84W, of the 6th P.M., Sheridan County, Wyoming, being described as follows: Commencing at the South 1/16 Corner of Sections 1 and 2, thence N00°29'23"E 39.60 feet, along the East line of said Southeast 1/4, to the Point of Beginning; thence N82°00'23"W 151.29 feet; thence N49°06'15"W 65.67 feet to a point on the East line of WESCO Subdivision, as recorded in Book W of Plats, Page 50; thence N00°29'23"E 32.83 feet, along said East line; thence S49°06'15"E 79.57 feet; thence S82°00'23"E 140.61 feet to a point on the East line of said Southeast 1/4; thence S00°29'23"W 25.22 feet, along said East line, to the Point of Beginning.
