**EASEMENT.**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That the Sheridan Press Brick and Tile Co., a corporation duly incorporated under the laws of the State of Wyoming, in the consideration of the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant and demise unto the Chicago, Burlington & Quincy Railroad Company, its successors and assigns, the right of way and the right to construct, maintain and operate a standard

railroad track with a clearance of not less than eight and one half (8½) feet on each side of the center line of said railroad track for all buildings except grain elevators, in which case the clearance shall be ten and one half (10½) feet from said center line; as the said track is now located over and across a part of the northwest quarter (NW¼) of the northeast quarter (NE¼) of section thirty-five (35), township fifty-six (56) north, range eighty-four (84) West of the Sixth P.M. in Sheridan County, Wyoming, extending from the west line of the northwest quarter (NW¼) of the north east quarter (NE¼) of said Section 35 to the end of the track at the plant of the grantors herein.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said railroad company, its successors and assigns so long as said railroad track shall be operated upon said premises.
