A tract of land located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 13, Township 53 North, Range 84 West of the 6th P.M., more particularly described as follows:

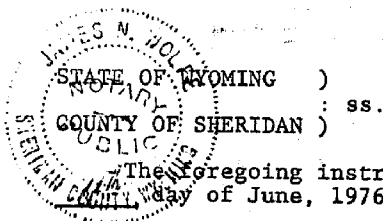
A tract of land 33 feet in width lying immediately East of, adjacent to, and parallel with the West boundary of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the aforesaid Section, beginning at a point approximately 465.6 feet South of the point where the State Secondary Highway intersects the West line of the aforesaid SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and thence running South to the South line of the aforesaid SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 13.

ALSO, a 30 foot wide tract of land bearing immediately North of, adjacent to, and parallel with the South line of the aforesaid SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the said Section 13, running from the West line of the said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Easterly a distance of 659.54 feet, more or less, to the West boundary line of a tract of land owned by the Presbytery of Wyoming of the Synod of the Rockies of the United Presbyterian Church in the U.S.A.
