RIGHT OF WAY DEED.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:-

That Eaton Brothers Inc. a corporation, duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Wyoming, does hereby, in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto EDWARD A. WHITNEY, of Sheridan County, Wyoming, grantee, a right of way for the ditch, known as the Whitney ditch, passign through sections thirty three (33), twenty nine (29) twenty eight (28), twenty (20) and twenty one (21) in township fifty six (56) north of range eighty six (86) West of the 6th P.M., as shown by the accompanying map, copy of which ditch accompanied the petition of said Edward A. Whitney filed with the Board of Control of Wyoming for change in point of diversion from Wolf Creek Canon Ditch to the said Whitney ditch, the headgate of which Whitney Ditch is located on the north bank of Wolf Creek North 44° 30' West 2500 feet from the south east corner of said section thirty three (33) township and range aforesaid, granting herewith also the right of egress, ingress and regress in the adjoining said ditch to repair and maintain the said ditch in the capacity first constructed.

In witness whereof said Eaton Brothers Inc. have caused this deed to be duly executed by its Vice president and secretary, in accordance with a resolution of said corporation duly passed and adopted at a meeting of the Board of Directors duly held, and has further caused the seal of the said corporation to be duly hereto attached this 17th day of November A.D. 1916.
