**ORDER APPROVING FINAL REPORT, ACCOUNTING
 AND DECREE OF FINAL DISTRIBUTION**

Now, on this day, the above-captioned matter came before the Court in its regular order, pursuant to notice, on the Final Report, Accounting and Petition for Final Distribution as presented to the Court at this time by John F. Araas, of Yonkee & Toner, LLP, on behalf of the Personal Representatives of the above-captioned estate. The Court, having examined the Final Report, Accounting and Petition for Final Distribution, and the Court finding that the beneficiaries named in the Will, and the named heir-at-law of the decedent, having failed to object to the Final Report, Accounting and Petition for Final Distribution, or to appear at such hearing after receiving proper notice thereof pursuant to statute, as shown by the filed record herein, finds that it has full and complete jurisdiction over the subject matter and all interested parties, and therefore this matter ought to proceed on to final hearing and determination on the merits.

This matter proceeding on to final determination, the Court specifically finds that each and all of the statements made in the Final Report, Accounting and Petition for Final Distribution are true and correct; that the Personal Representatives and the attorneys for the Sheridan County, Wyoming estate have carefully, fully and properly administered and handled the estate in accordance with law and in accordance with all duties which they owe to the estate and to the beneficiaries and heir-at-law of the estate; that the administration of the Sheridan County, Wyoming estate is fully and finally concluded, and that the estate is ready for final distribution, and therefore Order ought to be entered at this time fully and finally approving, ratifying and confirming the Final Report, Accounting and Petition for Final Distribution, and all doings of the Personal Representatives and the attorneys in

the premises, and that Decree ought to be entered providing for the full and final distribution of the estate and the closing thereof.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the requisite notice of this hearing on the Final Report, Accounting and Petition for Final Distribution was duly given pursuant to Wyoming statute by the Personal Representatives, and that the named beneficiaries of this estate, and the named heir-at-law of the decedent, have not objected timely to the proposed Final Report, Accounting and Petition for Final Distribution, or any statements therein, for the reason that they have failed to appear at such hearing, or to submit written objections within the time set forth in the Notice of Final Settlement of the estate.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Final Report, Accounting and Petition for Final Distribution be, and the same hereby is, fully and finally ratified, confirmed and approved, and that the Personal Representatives and the attorneys for the estate have carefully, fully and properly administered and handled the Sheridan County, Wyoming estate in accordance with law, and in accordance with all duties which they owe to the estate and to the named beneficiaries of the estate and the named heir-at-law of the decedent.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED this Court previously entered on November 23, 2020 an Order Approving Application for Allowance of Fees and Expenses for Attorneys for Estate, and Waiver of Personal Representatives' Fees, in which it allowed ordinary statutory fees and expenses for costs advanced, and to be advanced, for and by the attorneys for the estate, Yonkee & Toner, LLP, Sheridan, Wyoming, which Order is incorporated herein by reference. Such allowed ordinary statutory attorneys' fees in the amount of \$42,736.23, and the costs advanced to the date of entry of such Order, have been paid in full or reimbursed by the Personal Representatives pursuant to such Order of this Court. The attorneys for the estate shall further be entitled to any additional out-of-pocket expenses for costs advanced in winding up and closing the estate.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Personal Representatives shall proceed to make final distribution of all assets of this estate now in their hands, together with any and all other assets of the estate located in Sheridan County, Wyoming discovered hereafter and not described herein, and that the following-described property, and any such later-discovered property, after the payment of all costs of administration of the estate, including but not

limited to all costs advanced by the attorneys for the estate, is hereby distributed to the Honourable Henry "Harry" Malcolm Herbert, Broadspear Highclere Park Newbury Berks RG209RN United Kingdom, to-wit:

1. Real Property:

a. All right, title and interest in the real property and improvements comprising the Portsmouth House property, located at 58 Canyon Ranch Road, Big Horn, Sheridan County, Wyoming, more particularly described as follows:

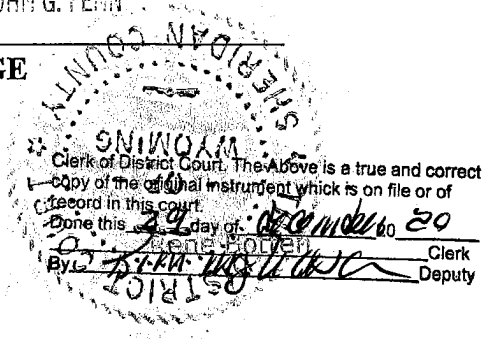

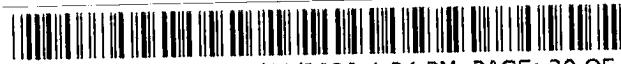
