This request was granted.

Findings for this request were as follows:

- 1. The variance granted is for the extension of a preexisting nonconforming building.
- 2. Given that the home previously had an enclosed porch in nearly an identical location, and the positive feedback from neighbors contacted, granting the special exemption is not contrary to the public interest, and is in harmony with the spirit of the zoning ordinance, as long as the property owner complies with other aspects of the zoning ordinance.
