ONE & No/100 - - Dollars, in consideration of which I hereby grant unto said Company, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate and maintain its lines of Telephone and Telegraph, including the necessary underground conduit, poles, cables, wires and fixtures upon, over and across the property which I own, or in which I have any interest, along the North boundary of Section Fifteen (15): Township 54 - North: Range 84 West: County of Sheridan and State of Wyoming and upon and along the roads, streets or highways adjoining the said property, with the right to permit the attachment of the wires of any other company, and the right to trim any trees along said lines so as to keep the wires cleared at least forty-eight inches, to erect and set the necessary guy and brace poles and anchors and to attach thereto the necessary guy wires.
