RIGHT OF WAY EASEMENT

Said road is located on and across the North Half of Section Sixteen, Township 54 North, Range 84 West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Sheridan County, Wyoming.

The above easement is granted with the understanding that the grantee, his heirs or assigns, shall maintain proper cattle guards and gates so as to prevent injury to livestock.

Hereby releasing and waiving all rights under and by virtue of the homestead exemption laws of the State of Wyoming.
