QUITCLAIM DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA acting by and through the GENERAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATOR, under and pursuant to the powers and authority contained in the provisions of the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949, Public Law 152, approved June 30, 1949, as amended, and applicable rules, regulations and orders for and in consideration of the Sum of Eighty-four Thousand One Hundred Twenty And No/100 Dollars (\$84,120.00) hereby sells and quitclaims to RUTH GEIER RICH, of Wrench Ranch, Sheridan, Wyoming, subject to the reservations and rights hereinafter set out, the following described land in the County of Sheridan, State of Wyoming, to wit:

That portion of Section 16, commencing at the corner common to Sections 15, 16, 21 and 22, Township 56 North, Range 84 West of the 6th P.M.; thence South 87°50' West along the section line, 5301.1 feet, more or less, to the corner common to Sections 16, 17, 20 and 21; thence North 0°03' East along the section line, 2534.4 feet; thence South 73°50' East, 816.2 feet; thence South 81°14' East, 1474.6 feet; thence North 21°56' East, 159.7 feet; thence North 79°44' East, 64.0 feet; thence South 54°34' East, 3185.7 feet; thence South 64°36' East, 97.7 feet; thence South 74°22' East, 238.5 feet; thence South 0°42' West, 86.7 feet, to the place of beginning.

The North Half (NE½) and the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE¼SE¼) of Section 17, except a .6258 acre portion thereof, described as beginning at the corner common to Sections 16, 17, 20 and 21, Township 56 North, Range 84 West of the 6th P.M., thence North 0°03' East, 2688.6 feet, more or less, to the quarter corner of said section as the true point of beginning; thence North 86°51' West, 208.0 feet; thence South 3°09' West, 104.0 feet; thence South 73°50' East, 221.1 feet; thence North 0°03' East, 154.2 feet, to the place of beginning; and

Section 8; Lot 1 and the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE¼NW¼) and the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW¼NE¼) of Section 30; and

Lots 2 and 3 of Section 31, all of said above described land being in Township 56 North, Range 84 West of the 6th P.M., containing 1383 acres, more or less.

TOGETHER WITH improvements and appurtenances thereto.

SUBJECT, HOWEVER, to the following reservations and rights:

1. Any state of facts which may be disclosed by a physical inspection and an accurate survey of the premises.
2. No water rights are included in the sale.
3. Use of the land is restricted to grazing purposes unless written approval for any other use is obtained by the purchaser from the Administrator of Veterans Affairs, or his designee.
4. Existing easements for public roads and highways, public utilities, irrigation ditches and pipelines, including, but not limited to the following:

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- (a) Easement of all property interests in the land comprising PLAT 7 and the lands shown as Section 17 in Plat 4, together with the right to install, repair and replace thereon.
 - (b) A thirty foot easement, extending from the fifteen feet on each side of Section 16, to the 300 feet, more or less, length of the front boundary of said Section 17, for use of the Rural Landowners Association (now the Federal Irrigation District) in connection with its operation of Agreements entered into May 17, 1938, between the Bureau of Reclamation and the Rural Associations Incorporated by the Department of Commerce.
 - (c) Easements for and right to discharge effluent from the sewage disposal plant and drainage of surface on other waters, in, on, over and across Sections 16 and 17 in Plat 4.
5. Rights are reserved for use and access to an old military cemetery by interested persons for care and maintenance, said cemetery being 300' x 300' in size, enclosed with a steel link fence, and located in the Southeast corner of Section 8. Grantee shall maintain and keep in repair the easement space in a condition to prevent livestock from entering and overcrowding the cemetery.
 6. The Government does not represent nor include in this conveyance access to the property.
