Statement

Water and Ditch Claim

John W. Sturgis of lawful age being first duly sworn upon his oath depose and say that his post office address is Buffalo Johnson County Wyoming Territory, that he is the owner of the following described ditch which is named and Known as the Lower Shell Creek Ditch; said ditch is taken out of the natural stream of water supply; the location of headgate for said ditch is in the E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section one (1) Township 52 N R 83 W in Johnson County Wyoming Territory; said ditch is 4.5 feet average width 1.00 feet deep and one mile long, the grade is 9.52 feet per mile and the general course is easterly and northerly. The date of appropriation of water by original construction of said ditch was the 1st day of June A. D. 1884. The amount of water claimed by said John W. Sturgis is 8.95 cubic feet per second of time. The present capacity of said ditch is 8.95 cubic feet per second and
