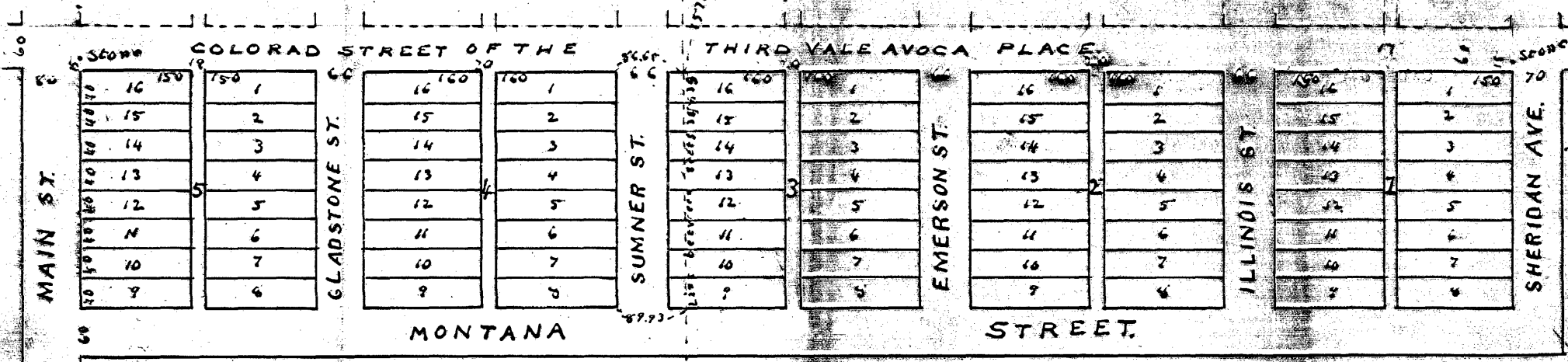


FOURTH VALE AVOCA PLACE

SHERIDAN CO. WYO.



I hereby certify that on the 30th and 31st days of Oct. 1902 I Surveyed Fourth Vale Avoca Place situated on a part of Sections 34 and 35 T. 56 N. R. 84 W as shown by the foregoing plat which is a correct delineation of said survey shown to a scale of 200 feet to an inch. The streets running N. and S. are extensions of those of same name in Third Vale Avoca Place and Montana St. is parallel with Colorado St. in Third Vale Avoca Place. Iron and Oak stakes are driven, well into the ground, at the front corners of each lot, and stone markers are low down in the ground at the places indicated on the plat. The width of streets, alleys and dimensions of lots and distances are indicated in feet and decimals by red figures on the plat. Each lot and block bears its own number. Witness my hand this 1st day of March 1903.

This certifies: That the Lincoln Land Company, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Nebraska, and authorized to do business in the State of Wyoming, is the present owner of those parts of Sections Thirty four (34) and Thirty five (35) in Township Fifty six (56) North, of Range Eighty four (84) West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, on which Fourth Vale Avoca Place is located, as shown by the foregoing plat and surveyor's certificate. That said owner has caused said land to be surveyed and platted as said Fourth Vale Avoca Place, as shown by said plat and Surveyor's certificate: That the streets, avenues and alleys indicated on said plat and mentioned in said Surveyor's certificate are hereby dedicated to the public use.
