made by the said Frank Heinrich according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands", and the acts supplemental thereto, for the Lots numbered three, five and six of Section fourteen and the North West quarter of the North West quarter of Section twenty-three, in Township fifty-eight North of Range eighty-eight West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Wyoming, containing one hundred and forty-three acres and fiftysix hundredths of an acre. according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the said Frank Heinrich.
