RIGHT OF WAY DEED

Mrs. Martha E. Snively Grantor, of Sheridan County, State of Eyoming, for and in consideration of the sum of right and privilege of tapping the city water main for domestic purposes and ----DOLLARS (\$50.00) the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grent, bargain, sell and convey unto City of Sheridan in the State of Wyoming, and its assigns, the following described

real estate, situate and being in the County of Sheridan and State of Wyoming, hereby releasing and waiving all rights under and by virtue of the Homestead Exemption Laws of the State of Wyoming, and which said real estate is for a water pipe line and more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at a point on the south line of the SWL NEL of Sec. 20, T55N, R85W, said point being 120 feet more or less, east of the southwest corner of said SW NEL; thence along a 13.7 degree ourve to the right in an easterly direction, a distance of 233 feet more or less; thence S 85° 30' E. 615.2 feet more or less, to the south line of said SW2 NET of Sec. 20.

The above description described the center line of said right-of-way which is ten feet wide. It is hereby agreed that the granting of this deed includes the right of ingress and egress to City officials and employee for the purpose of inspection or repair of said pipe line.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said above sesoribed premises unto the said party of the second part, City of Sheridan, and its assigns forever, together with the privileges, heriditaments and appurtenances thereunto in any wise appertaining or belonging, the seid property hereby conveyed being for the use and purposes of a public highway.
