RIGHT OF WAY EASEMENT AGREEMENT

THAT GRANTORS, for and in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, together with other good, valuable and legal consideration, as hereinafter provided, do hereby grant and convey unto the said Grantee, its licensees, successors, assigns and rapresentatives, the following rights and right-of-way easement or easements to be used in conjunction with the construction, reconstruction, alteration, replacement and maintenance of a sewage system in the Town of Dayton for the use of the public, and specifically the right to lay, maintain, inspect, alter, repair, operate, protect, remove and relay a sewer line for the collection and transportation of sewage, and such valves, fittings, fixtures, equipment and appurtenances as may be necessary or convenient for the operation of such sewer line or lines and sewage system over, through and under the following described real property belonging to said Grantors, and situate in the Town of Dayton, Sheridan County, Wyoming, to-wit:

A 20 foot wide strip of land located in the Town of Dayton, Wyoming, 10 feet on each side of a center line more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the North line on the South one-half of Lot No. 4 of Block No. 4 of the Henry Croghan Addition, said point also being located 33 feet North and 561 feet West more or less of the Southeast corner of said Lot No. 4; thence South 20°26' West, 141 feet more or less to a point on the South line of the North one-half of Lot No. 6 of said Block No. 4, said point also being located 33 feet South and 606 feet West more or less from the Northeast corner of said Lot No. 6.
