Reynolds, widower, of the County of Sheridan, State of Wyoming, in consideration of the sum of one dollar, in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby conferred and acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the United States, the following real estate, in the County of Sheridan, State of Wyoming, to wit: - the right to lay and construct and maintain to, over and across the lands hereinafter described, a pipe line for the purpose of conducting water to Fort Mackenzie Wyoming; said pipe line to be covered to the depth of five (5) feet; and also the perpetual right of way to the extent of a strip of land ten (10) feet in width, to, over and across the said land in conformity with the Engineer's survey and plat, now on file in the office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Chander, Wyoming; and according to the line of said pipe, being five (5) feet on each side of said pipe line, as the same shall be hereafter constructed, laid and maintained to, over and across said land; and containing in all, forty four one hundredths (44/100) acres of land, together with the perpetual right of ingress, egress and regress, to, over and across the said described land, within the line of said right of way, said land being described as follows, to wit: - Across the North west quarter of Section 29 Town 56 North, Range 84 West 6 P.M.
