## AGREEMENT.

THIS AGREEMENT made on this 18th day of September 1911, by and between Coffeen Improvement Company, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Wyoming party of the first part, and E. Gillette of Sheridan, Wyoming, party of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That Whereas the said party of the

first part is the owner of Lots Seven (7) and Eight (8) of Block Eight (8) of the Original Townsite Of Sheridan, Wyoming, and the said party of the second part is the owner of Lots Five (5) and Six (6) of said Block Eight (8) of the Original Townsite of Sheridan, Wyoming;

NOW THEREFORE the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred (\$600.00) Dollars, to wit, in hand paid by the said party of the second part, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has sold and by these presents sells and conveys unto the said party of the second part, an undivided one-half ( $1/2$ ) interest in and to the North wall of the two story brick building, situated on the Southwest corner of the said Block Eight (8) of the original townsite of Sheridan, Wyoming, and the foundation thereto.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said one half ( $1/2$ ) interest during the life of the said wall in its useful condition for use as a partition wall or until it shall be mutually agreed upon to take down the said partition wall, but no part or interest or title to any land beneath the said wall which belongs to the said Coffeen Improvement Company, a corporation, is hereby conveyed or sold to the said party of the second part, but an interest in the wall and foundation only is conveyed hereby.
