State of _____ the following described real estate, situate in *Sheridan* County,
and State of *Wyoming* hereby releasing and waiving all rights under and by virtue of the homestead and exemption laws
of the State, to-wit: *a right of way for the Sheridan Dig Home road,*
twenty feet on each side of the center line described as
beginning at a point on the north line of section twenty
four (24) township fifty five (55) north range eighty four
(84) east of the 6th P.M. at station 266 + 35.6 according
to the survey made by the Wyoming Highway Department, which
is 118 feet east of the north quarter corner of said
section 24, thence 317.4 feet south 31.51 feet across the
