To the Public

Vacating streets and alleys in part of
Little Second Addition and pt. of Alley
in Block 3 Coffeen's 2nd Addition to the

Town of Sheridan.

Be it Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of
Sheridan:

Section 1. That the following described streets and alleys in
Little Second addition to the Town of Sheridan County of Sher-
idan and State of Wyoming be, and the same are hereby vacated,
to wit:-

1st Water street from the south line of College street to the
north line of Heald Street. 2nd. The alley in Block No. 25.

3rd. Sheridan Avenue from south line of College street to
the north line of Coffeen Avenue.

4th. The Alley in Block No. 10.

5th The right of way for channel of Little Goose Creek and the alley on either side thereof from south line of Gillelles Second addition to the south line of Heald Street.

6th Also that part of the alley in Block Three (3) between 2nd addition which runs north westerly from west of the west line of North and south alley produced to the south line of said north-west alley. Section 2. An emergency exists, and it is so declared, therefore this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.

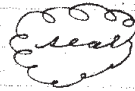
